1 liter NS for irrigation

Dressings:

¼ Dakins 1 bottle,

soft sorb (size 6x9 x2 and 9x15 x2)

Burn Time Out:

- Meshes
- Extra blades
- Recell
- Exparel
- Dermatome
- Skin substitute
- Body region
- Repositioning
- Clysis
- Extra hemostatics
- Blood products needed

“EXCISION”

e.g.
skin grafts,
substitutes
involving excision

Opened:
**Minor Burn Tray,
Burn Setup (3 packs)**

Debridement: Five 0.24 Weck blades
Hemostatic: warm Epi Soaked Telfas and Laps
Dressings: ACE dressings

Hemostatic:

quikclot 1 roll
phenylephrine clysis soln 1 liter

Dressings:

¼ Dakins 1 bottle,
kerlix (4),
soft sorb (size 6x9 x2 and 9x15 x2)

“COMPLEX”

e.g.
large areas for
excision, grafting

Consider stay
on vent if FiO2 >50

Opened:
**Minor Burn Tray x2,
Burn Setup (3 packs)**

Debridement: Ten 0.24 Weck blades + Watson
Hemostatic:

warm Epi Soaked Telfas and Laps
quikclot 1 roll

Dressings:

ACE dressings x4 four inch, x4 six inch
teflas small

Hemostatic:

quikclot extra roll
phenylephrine clysis soln, ask about
quantity

Dressings:

¼ Dakins 2 bottle,
kerlix (4),
soft sorb (size 6x9 x2 and 9x15 x2)
