

STANDARD DRESSINGS *

Primary dressing: Telfa Clear over ReCell

Secondary Dressing: Xeroform, Kerlix, Sofsorb, Ace Wraps DRESSING CARE AT 48 HOURS **

Secondary dressings are taken down by MD or CRNP, and RN team

-care taken to avoid shear of the telfa clear/ Suprathel

Inspect the treated areas for graft take and infection

Secondary dressings are replaced: xeroform, absorptive dressings (kerlix, sofsorb, ace wraps).

ASCENDING CYSTOTOXIC AGENTS

NS
Silver Nitrate soln
% Dakins
Acetic acid
% Dakins
Full strength dakins
Mafenide acetate / nystatin

DRESSING CARE AT 7 days – telfa clear removal ****

Secondary dressings are taken down by MD or CRNP, and RN team –

- -Do not force telfa clear off; it should come away of its own accord
- -Trim as needed
- -Avoid ointments, silver dressings, or any cytotoxic topicals

Cover ReCell with same dressing (new telfa clear) until graft stable, then can transition to dermanet / soft dressings / ACE

-Protect against secondary trauma (very vulnerable for 2 weeks)
