

Trauma Floor Team Admission Criteria

<p>Patients will be admitted to the most appropriate floor team based on the following criteria. Some patients will be appropriate for both teams, and the TICU attending on call will determine which team will admit those patients.</p>	
<p>Trauma 1: APP Team</p>	<p>Trauma 2: Resident Team</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Geriatric patients - Patients with multiple co-morbidities - Spinal cord injuries - Traumatic brain injuries - Isolated orthopedic injuries 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Post-operative patients who were operated on by the trauma team - Intra-abdominal & intrathoracic injuries that may require surgery - Vascular injuries (not BCVI) - Extensive wound care needs that cannot be managed at the bedside
<p>Trauma 1 will not admit more than 18 patients at a time. Patients may be transitioned between teams by the trauma attending as needed.</p> <p>Trauma 1 will check out to the upper-level resident each evening and receive checkout from them each morning. The Kolkin list will be used to communicate with the night team. Therefore, the Kolkin list should include ONLY pertinent data that the night team needs to know. Remove old or excessive details that distract from relevant information. Be sure to include specific concerns that may develop/escalate overnight.</p>
