This research is in collaboration with Dr. Jo Ann Otts, CON facutly and aims to evaluate students' ability to identify strengths and weaknesses of each tool and to determine which tool is more effective in terms of accuracy, relevance and efficiency. We also aim to provide insight in the effectiveness of generative Al research tools in nursing and promote critical thinking in nursing students and future nurse leaders when selecting a literature search tool.
