## Information Security Awareness Training

USA policy requires all employees to complete the SANS Securing the Human Cybersecurity training program within 90 days of being hired. It will be conducted through the System Administration, Networking, and Security (SANS) Advanced Cybersecurity Learning Platform (ACLP) that provides the University community with the knowledge of how to uphold the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of both professional and personal data.

It is designed to increase the awareness of information security responsibilities that you hold as an employee, and to help you recognize online threats to our systems, networks and information.

This training is mandatory for all staff, faculty and student workers who access university networks and systems as part of their jobs. All employees to whom this applies will receive an email from Canvas with logon instructions.
